Teacher/ Student Opportunity Grants Presented by the AHS Class of 1962

In category one, the Alliance High School Class of 1962 is pleased to offer grants to provide financial assistance to worthy and responsible graduates of Alliance High School, male or female, in any field of undergraduate study. In category two, grants are available for high school teachers to enhance their knowledge and enthusiasm by engaging in activities relevant to their teaching field.

Grants are **not** primarily intended to fund basic tuition and expenses at a college or university. The intention is to provide assistance for activities that supplement/compliment the educational experience. Examples might include funding for study or travel abroad, participation in art, music, or dance workshop, internships in the workplace either in United States or foreign countries.

The intention is to annually distribute funds for these awards. Funds will be distributed upon completion of the activity. In addition, a one-page synopsis of the benefits of the activity must be submitted to the AHS Foundation upon completion of the activity. Priority will be given to those who have not been previous grant recipients. Reapplication is required for possible refunding.

Alliance High School, show academic promise, determination, responsibility, curiosity, ambition and have financial need

Teachers must show determination, responsibility, curiosity and ambition
